Tournament: GM MIX

1. General Regulations

The **Stockholm Chess Federation Talent Tournaments - Hotel Stockholm North by First Hotels Young Talents** is a series of round-robin and Swiss system chess tournaments with classical time control, offering players the opportunity to achieve all kinds of international title norms. The competitions are governed by the FIDE Laws of Chess currently in force.

2. Tournament Overview

Venue:	Hotel Stockholm North by First Hotels Johanneslundsvägen 12, 194 61 Upplands Väsby, Sweden
Specific Tournament:	GM MIX Tournament
Dates:	06–11 of January, 2027
Time Control:	90 minutes for each player for the entire game, with an increment of 30 seconds per move starting from move one.
Participants:	Total quantity of participants – 48, including 10 grandmasters.
Average Rating:	At least 2290.
Default Time:	30 minutes.

4. Tie-Break Criteria

- **1. Direct Encounter** — DE
- **2. Buchholz Tie-Break** Variable
- **3. Sonneborn-Berger Tie-Break** Variable
- **4. FIDE Tie-Break** Number of Wins / Games Won — WIN / WON

5. FIDE Title Norms

The certification and approval of any potential norms, scored during the tournament are conducted in accordance with the FIDE Title Regulations, following their verification by the FIDE Qualification Commission.

6. Important Notes & Regulations

- **Postponement or Delay:** Postponement or delay of the start of a game is only possible if the players, prior to the start of the round, have approached the Chief Arbiter with a valid, compelling reason (such as force majeure medical circumstances or a transport collapse).
- **Fair Play Restrictions:** During play the players are forbidden to use any notes, sources of information or advice, or analyse any game on another chessboard.
- **Electronic Devices:** During a game, a player is forbidden to have any electronic device not specifically approved by the arbiter in the playing venue.
- **Media & Photography:** The authorised photographers may take photographs without flash during the round in the playing area. These photographs may be published in media and information materials dedicated to the tournaments. If a player wishes to have their photos removed from the organizer's social media or website, they may contact the Chief Organizer of the tournaments regarding this matter.

- **Amendments:** The tournament organizers reserve the right to make minor amendments to the tournament regulations.
