RULES & REGULATIONS



1



SYSTEM OF PLAY

FIDE Swiss System with Rapid Regulations will be followed.

2



TIME CONTROL

15 Minutes + 3 Seconds increment from move 1 in rapid and 3 Minutes + 2 Seconds increment from move 1 in blitz.

3



ROUNDS

6 rounds both in rapid and blitz.

4



ELIGIBILITY

The tournament is open for all players.

5



TIE-BREAK

Buchholz Cut 1, Buchholz, Sonneborn Berger, Direct encounter, number of wins (including forfeit points).

6



INTERPRETATION

For interpretation of the rules and deciding any point not covered by the rules, the decision of the organizers shall be final and binding.

7



PROTESTS

Protests, if any against the decision of the arbiter shall be made in-writing with a protest fee **Rs.1000/-** (Rs. One Thousand only) within 10 minutes of the incident. The protest fee is refundable only if the protest is upheld. The decision of the organizers on all protests shall be final and binding.

8



ONE PRIZE PER PLAYER

One player will be given one(higher) prize only.

9



WITHDRAWALS

A player may withdraw at any stage of the event, after informing the Chief Arbiter in writing.

10



AGE & GENDER

All age players & all gender players will play together.

11



ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Players are not allowed to use any type of wrist watch, mobile, or any such electronic device in the playing area., if found will be considered lost for the game.

12



RIGHT TO ACCEPT / REJECT

Organizer has the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason.

13



CLOCKS

Clocks will be placed only on top 5 Boards, after 30 Minutes of game if arbitor feels a game is taking longer time to finish, then they can put a clock at any moment with 3 Minutes + 2 Seconds increment.

14



PRIZE DISTRIBUTION

All prize winners are bound to attend the prize distribution ceremony if they want to claim their prizes.

15



SPECIAL CATEGORIES



BEST SCHOOL TROPHY

Will be given to school with maximum registration.



BEST GIRL TROPHY

Will be given to girl under 18 year of age.



BEST FEMALE TROPHY

Will be given to female over 18 year of age.
