Time control = 10/10 (10 minutes starting time each, no increment). 1 clock per board

The following **tie-break systems** will be used (in the order listed):

- 1) Score; 2) Direct Encounter; 3) Bucholz; 4) Sonneborn-Berger; 5) Cumulative

Tournament Arrangements:

- 1.) Right of admission reserved.
- 2.) No more than one prize will be awarded to any player/team. Prizes will not be shared but allocated according to the results from the tie-break systems.
- 3.) Prizes awarded for '**Best Dressed Team**' and '**Best Team Name**'.
- 4.) Players must attend prize-giving, to qualify for prizes. This will be held after the last round in each section.
- 5.) **Round1 will be forfeited** should you not have entered and paid before the close of registration (07h30) and **you will start from Round2**.
- 6.) Players must ensure that they are sitting at the correct boards. Players found to be playing at the wrong board will forfeit the game.
- 7.) Notation not compulsory
- 8.) No parent or player will be allowed in the chess playing area (space where the chess equipment is placed) before the start of the tournament.



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- 9.) No parent or player will be allowed in the chess playing area (space where the chess equipment is placed) or the PC operator table, before the tournament has started.
- 10.) No item may be sold or traded by any person other than those given permission, in writing, by the tournament organiser.
- 11.) By entering this tournament, the player agrees unconditionally to abide by all the rules and regulations.
- 12.) The organisers of the tournament are not responsible for the safety of players or their property.
- 13.) Latest Fide, Chess SA and Sedibeng Tournament rules will apply.
- 14.) Only players who are registered with Chess SA and have paid their yearly Chess SA registration fees in full (are in good standing with Chess SA) will be able to gain rating points.
- 15.) Tuck shop available. **Chess equipment will be on sale (Susan Mittermaier – 076 750 6680).**
- 16.) No alcohol consumption or smoking on the premises.
- 17.) **Pairings will also be displayed prominently at the venue. It remains the player's responsibility to know their board number, colour and start time of the next round. There will also be a WhatsApp group for the tournament. Please make sure you join the group.**

Registration process (Online Entries Only):

- 3) No refunds. If you withdraw or do not show up, you forfeit your entry fee.

- 6) Only players whose payments have been confirmed, will be published and put into the pairings for Round1.
- 7) It will be each player's own responsibility to check the players list on www.chess-results.com and refer all queries to **Yolande Blignaut (081 737 8449)** before **Friday evening 20h00.**
